

2008 Turfgrass Selection and Identification Workshop



Presented by the UMass Extension Turf Program

The ultimate performance of a stand of turf depends on matching turfgrass species and varieties with site characteristics, intended use and maintenance level, and knowing what you have is the key to knowing how to manage it. In this hands-on workshop, participants will learn to identify and recognize the principal cool season turfgrasses and how to select cultivars for specific characteristics such as disease resistance, drought tolerance, wear tolerance, and vigor.

Cost: \$100/person (pre-registration required, space is limited, includes lunch and parking permit). 5 pesticide contact hours for all New England states have been approved for category 37 (turf), licensed applicator, and category 32 (sod). 1 additional contact hour will be awarded to those participating in a free optional NTEP session at the Joseph Troll Turf Research Center in South Deerfield.
